6:35		Property & Building	\$10k on accurate site plan to propose to several nonprofit developers to develop back 6 acres for lease income, to come from Building Fund or Imagine 2025. Do we need congregational approval? Jeff says Yes, and this is 1st step. No access over Fern Hill property, so access another way. Deb Kutzko, current Fern Hill president, maybe develop addition to Fern Hill? \$10k should come from Imagine 2025 funds? Parish House sale may provide \$700k, take \$600k to endowment, rest to Building Fund for \$80k roof. Senior housing is good match to OZ's mission. Plan is to use up i25 funds on current needs, so not much left to cover this. Also plan to expand Preschool, so help close projected \$70k annual shortfall. Communication plan?

7:40	HR Committee proposal (1st read) - Discussion	Vivien, Mindy, Molly, Rick Hecht, Keith Casper - recommending parental leave, 4 options, HR recommending 12 weeks paid leave. Added Short Term Disability (for women only). Should Preschool follow OZ's HR policies? They are paid differently than other staff. The DIFFERENCE in cost between sub to cover the work and the payment to staff is \$3k for Preschool and \$5k for top paid office staff. This is for parental care not family leave. Why consider this now? Preschool staff is having a baby soon. Is this number one issue? Is this more important than raises for Preschool? This could be an issue for , a new rabbi. Difference in paternity vs maternity leave from EE viewpoint? Rabbi candidates will probably require 12 weeks paid parental leave. Where does money come from? Preschool reserve or OZ net.
