	Development Committee report	\$39k surplus year-to-date is \$60k lower than the \$100k surplus at the end of January, so we had a \$60k loss in February. We are using \$110k of PPP funds to shore up the \$200k loss Salaries are extremely private. Only new board members get to see salaries. I2025 funds replenished thanks to generous donors. Bill is prepping for June congregational meeting. Our numbers are lower. Dues and income have not changed. Need new income sources. Need a practical and realistic budget moving forward.
