Mike called Rabbi Amy and asked, what is this? Rabbi Amy offered to meet with UVM President — start by meeting with Provost and Mike Schirling together Thursday — Rabbi Edleson and JCVT (with Yoram's assistance) also sent a letter- rabbis taking individual roles to help students and professors and alumni — Rabbi Amy will now discuss with UVM instead of writing a letter
